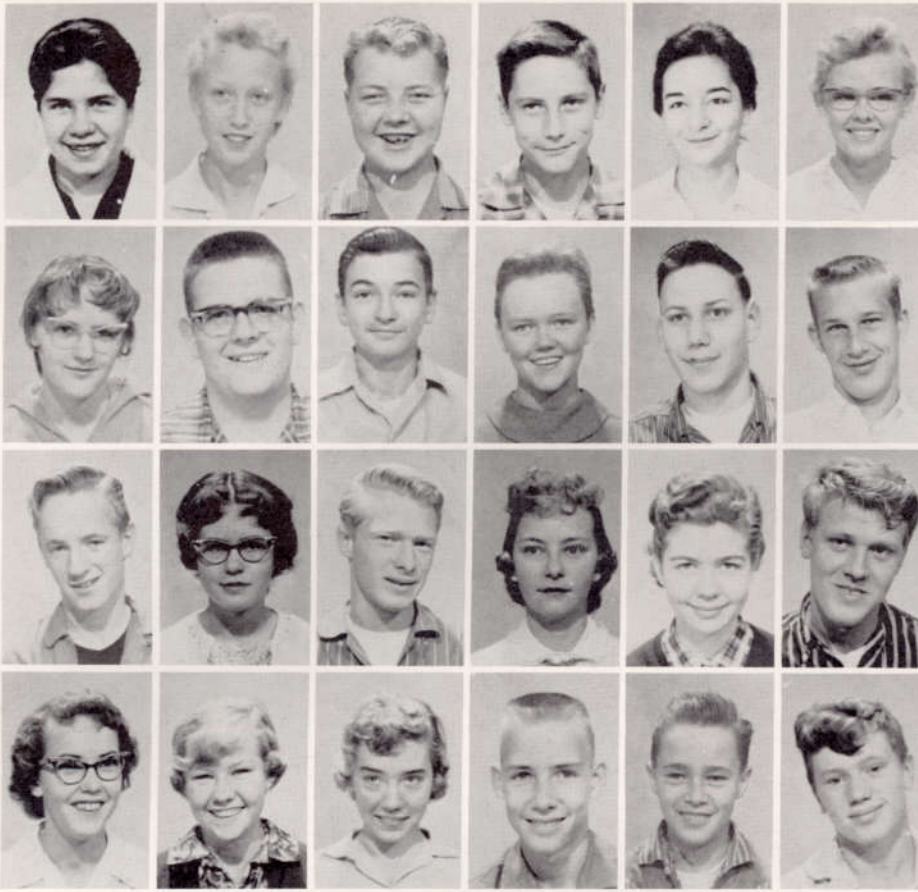

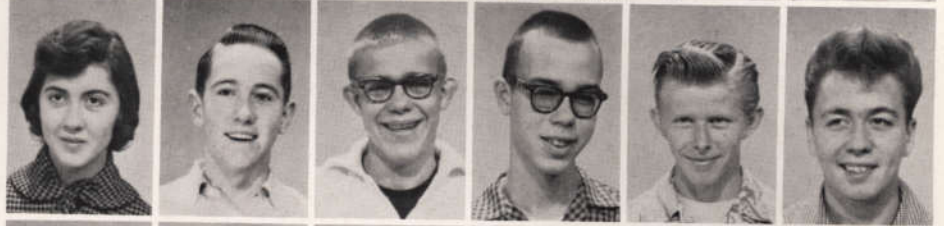

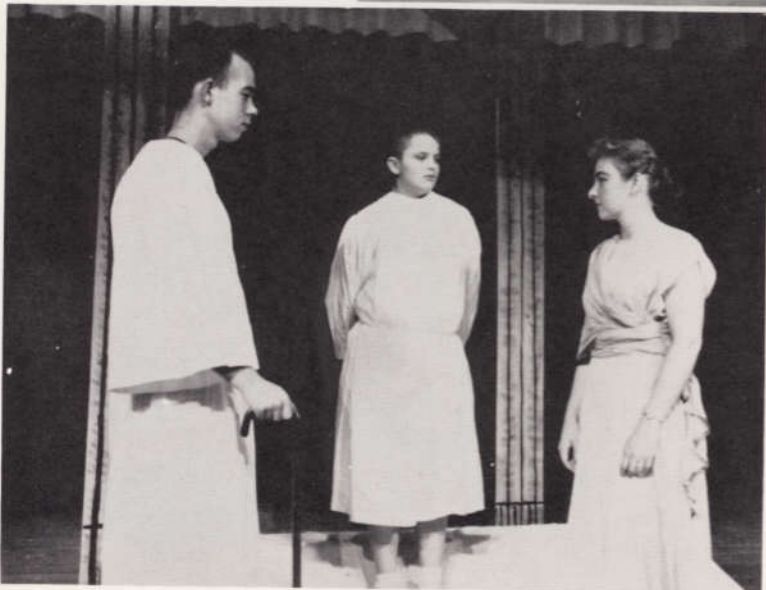

Craig Rulien, Dan Barron, and Sharry Scholz are a few of the many sophomores who took part in this production.

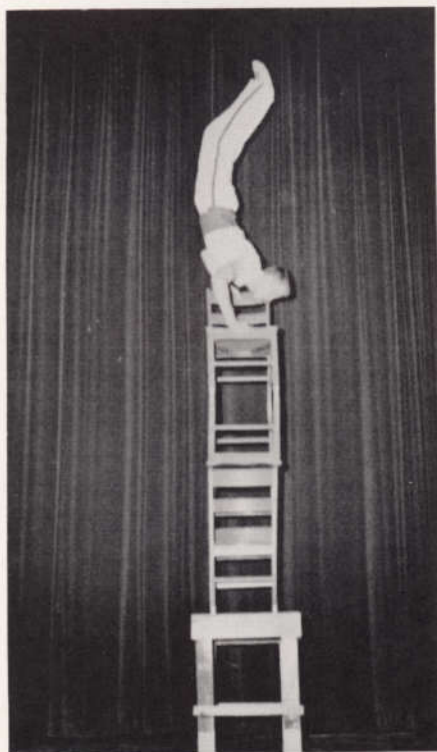
