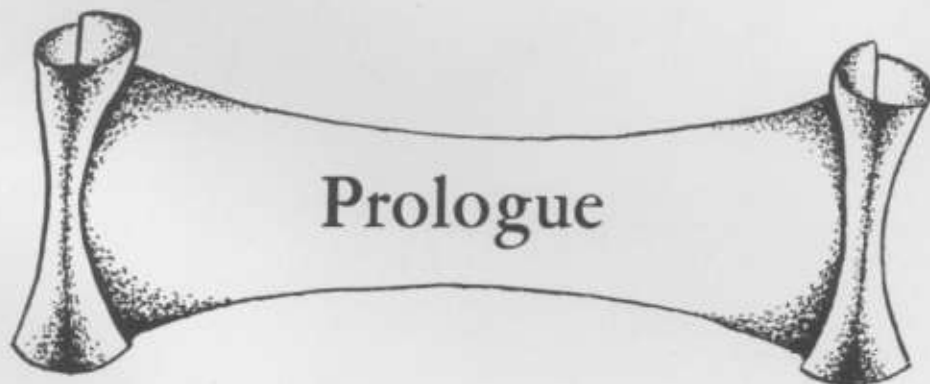

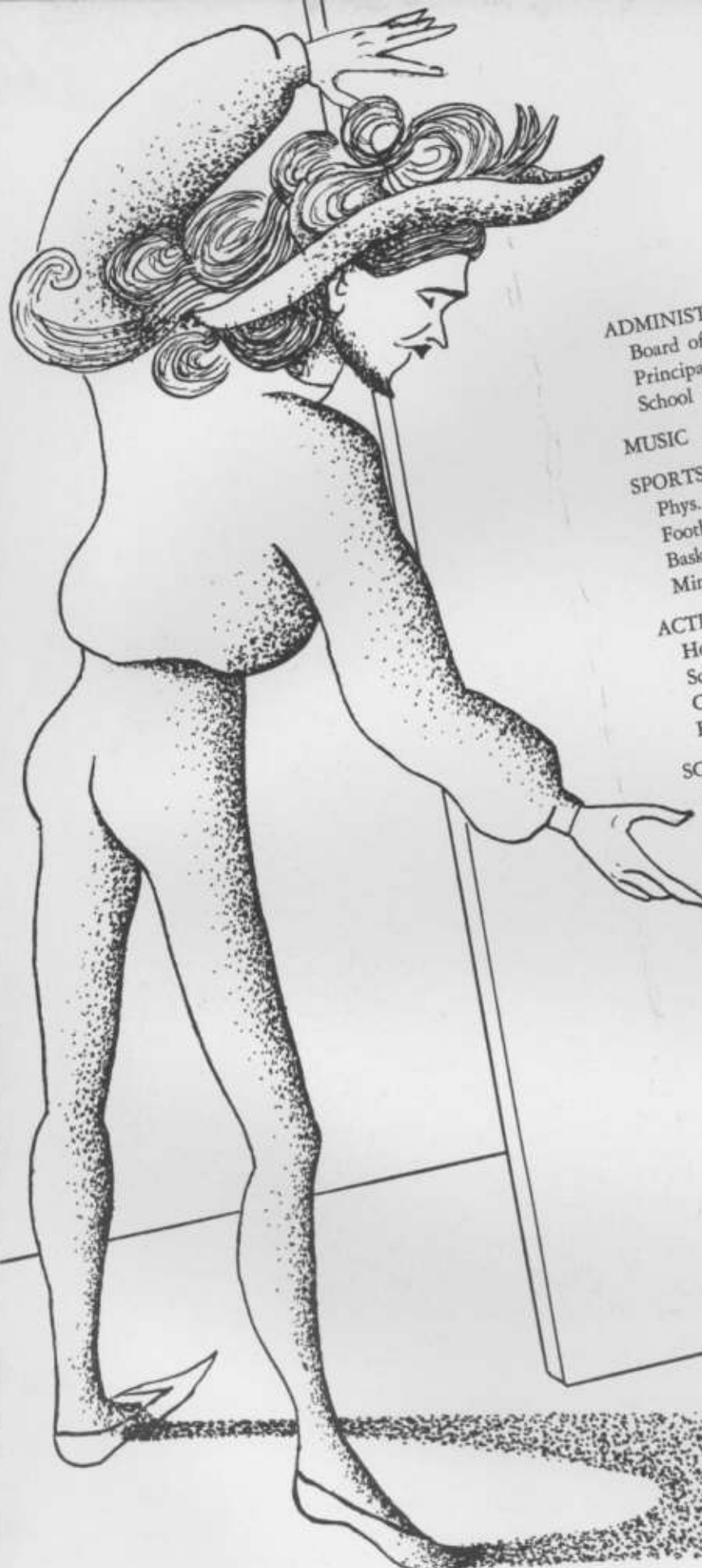


Dear Mrs. Coffman,
