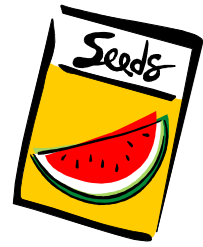




## News of the Month -- March 2008 Memorial High School Class of 1959 Eau Claire, Wisconsin
